The following School proposals are being considered: **Bath Community Schools** (Bonding Proposal); **East Lansing Public Schools** (Bonding Proposal); **Haslett Public Schools** (Operating Millage Renewal); and **Laingsburg Community Schools** (Sinking Fund Millage Proposal).
