

Bath Charter Township Parks & Recreation Fall 2018 Events

If you would be interested in being a vendor at the October 13 **Craft/Trinket Sale**, you must register by September 30 in the Bath Township Offices. The event will run from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. at the Bath Community Center (5959 Park Lake Road – Bath). The fee to participate starts at \$10.00 (includes 1-8' table & 2 chairs) and increases to \$15.00 (includes 2-8' tables & 2 chairs with electricity). Additional tables are \$5.00 each. Food and animals may not be sold.

Truck or Treat will be held on Monday, October 22 in the north parking lot of Bath High School from 6-7 p.m. Youth are invited to come dressed for the occasion and trick or treat at various businesses taking part in passing out candy. A back up date of October 29 has been scheduled in the event of poor weather on October 22.

Buck Pole will be held on November 15 at the Bath Township Senior Center. Those lucky enough to take a deer on the opening day of the Firearm season are invited to hang their deer (buck or doe) on the Buck Pole for an opportunity to win a prize. Door prizes will be given away and refreshments will be served. The pole is open from 6:00-8:30 p.m. This free event is open to the public.

Men's and Women's Open Gym Basketball is open to Bath residents on Sunday's through May 2019. Women meet from 2-4 p.m. and men from 4-6 p.m. in the Bath Middle School gym. Men must be ages 25+ and women 21+ to participate. Simply register at the first event and sign in at subsequent visits.

A 1-day **Hunter Safety** classes are offered on November 10. Registration takes place in the Twp. Office until 1 week prior to the class or until 40 registrations are received (whichever comes first). Once registered, participants will be issued the 85-page class book that must be read and the Chapter Review questions in the back of the book completed prior to attending. Upon arrival to class, registrants will present their completed questions to the instructor and pay their \$3.00 class fee. The class will consist of reviewing the material in the book, a law and ethics portion with a Conservation Officer, a shooting experience and a hunter safety exam. Those participating in the full day event and passing the hunter safety exam will be issued their card prior to leaving. This program is open to anyone of any age.

Gentle Yoga is offered for ages 18+ on Mondays at the BCC from 5:15-6:15 p.m. Each 6-week session costs \$36.00. The next session begins on September 24. Gentle Yoga will add a Wednesday night session beginning November 14 from 6:15-7:15 p.m. This class does not accept drop-ins. Registration takes place at the event.

Zumba is offered to ages 18+ on Thursdays from 6:00-7:00 for a fee of \$30.00/6 week session or \$7.00/night (drop-in). The program meets in the BCC through September 27 however beginning in October the class will move to the Bath Senior Center (14480 Webster Road – Bath). Registration takes place at the event.

The **Annual Fishing Contest** on Park Lake continues with tagged panfish and pike. Take a fish with a 2018 tag and bring the tag to the Township Offices to claim your prize. All DNR rules apply. Note: We only need the tag, not the fish.

Instruction sessions will be held on Wednesdays, October 24 and November 7 in the BCC from 6:00-7:30 p.m. when registrants will learn how to plan your sale items and become familiar with an Excel Spreadsheet. One parent is required to accompany their entrepreneur at the sale event and assist with the exchange of currency. Each registrant will receive at least 1-8' table to display their wares for the sale. Food items to be sold must be pre-packaged from the store (no home baked/cooked items) and the sale of animals is prohibited. 100% of the money received from the sales will be the property of each entrepreneur. What a great way to make money for holidays. Registration is free and will take place in the Bath Township Offices through October 18. A minimum of 10 students is needed.
