

Bath Charter Township Parks & Recreation HUNTER SAFETY 2-Day Class



Dates: August 10 & 11, 2019 (2-day class)

Time: 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (please arrive 15 minutes early on Saturday for processing)

Location: **Rose Lake Shooting Range (14500 Peacock Road – Bath)**

Registration: **Bath Charter Township Offices (14480 Webster Road – Bath)**

Begins June 3 and will continue through August 1, 2019 providing space is still available.

Cost: \$3.00 (to be paid upon arrival to class)

Equipment Needed: None – all equipment is provided

Registration is offered on a first come, first served basis, with limited enrollment. To register, please visit the Bath Twp. Offices (14480 Webster Road – Bath).

Open to everyone, the Hunter Safety class is designed to produce safe, knowledgeable, and responsible hunters. This 2-day class will be taught by Doug Hastings and held at the Rose Lake Shooting Range from 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 10 **AND** 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Sunday, August 11. The instructor will issue each student the Hunter Safety book upon arrival on Saturday, lecture from the book over these two days, offer a shooting experience, and proctor the final exam. Those completing the course and passing the final exam will be issued a Hunter Safety Certificate prior to leaving. This certificate can be taken to your local sporting goods department for the purchase of a hunting license.

Participants are asked to bring a sack lunch for each class day. Refrigeration is located on site, if needed. All equipment needed for the class will be provided. Please come dressed for the weather as class will take place rain or shine.

Parents are **highly encouraged** to attend with their child; however, if your student is under the age of 11, a parent or guardian **must** attend with the participant. Please join your child for this educational experience.
