June 18 Participate in the summer bowling night at **City Limits East** from 5-8 p.m. The program includes 2 games of bowling and a pair of rental shoes. The program is free to Bath Twp. residents. Programs

Baseball Games – Ages 4-7 – T-ball Mondays and Wednesdays from 6-8 in Wiswasser Park. Little Sluggers Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6-8 in Wiswasser Park. Games take place during the month of June.

Flag Football Registration – Open to boys and girls in grades K-3 for the school year 2019-2020, register in the Bath Township Offices June 3-August 2. Practices held in Bath and games will be held off-site. Parent volunteer coaches are needed.

U6 Soccer Registration – Open to boys and girls born in 2014 & 2015. Register in the Bath Township Offices June 3-August 2. Clinic is held at the Bath Township Soccer Park on Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30. Registration includes both Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 sessions. Volunteer coaches are needed.

Dance – Program runs June 19-August 1 from 5:00-5:50 in the BCC for you in grades 1-5. Registration takes place in the Bath Township Offices May 1-June 3. The Dance program will culminate with a mandatory performance during Bath Days (first weekend in August). Participants will need to provide shorts, a t-shirt and a pair of white canvas tennis shoes. Time permitting, tumbling will also be taught.

Hunter Safety – This 2-day class will be held on August 10 & 11 at the Rose Lake Shooting Range from 8-4 daily. Participants must pre-register in the Bath Township Offices (June 3-August 1), attend the 2-day class and pass the Hunter Safety exam to receive their Hunter Safety Certificate. A class fee of \$3.00 will be charged when you arrive to class. This opportunity is open to the public.

Fishing Contest – Fish have been tagged in Park Lake for the past 4 years. Catch a fish with a 2019 tag, remove the tag and bring to the Bath Twp. Offices to select a prize. All DNR rules apply.
