

Bath Charter Township Parks & Recreation HUNTER SAFETY 2020



Open to everyone, the Hunter Safety class is designed to produce safe, knowledgeable, and responsible hunters. Class will be taught by Mr. Doug Hastings. Two options are available for the DNR Hunter Safety class; Home Study or Field Study. Each is followed by a class day at the Rose Lake Shooting Range in Bath, MI. Do not delay to register as class space is limited to 18 participants per session due to the Coronavirus.

Home Study - As a Home Study student, you will be issued the classroom book when you register in the Bath Twp. Offices. This book must be read (84 pages) and Chapter Review questions in the back of the book must be completed before attending class. When you arrive to class, the instructor will ask to see your completed Chapter Review Questions so make sure to bring your book to class. The Home Study book is free however a \$1.00 class participation fee will be collected when you process through registration at the range.

Field Study - Those who took the DNR online Hunter Safety course can call 517-641-5167 to register for the Field Study portion. **YOU MUST BRING YOUR CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION FOR THE ONLINE CLASS TO THE HUNTER SAFETY CLASS AS VERIFICATION THAT YOU HAVE COMPLETED THE ONLINE COURSE.** A \$1.00 class fee will be collected when you process through registration at the shooting range.

Class - Everyone must also register for and attend a class listed below. Upon arrival to class, field study students will need to have a parent/guardian sign their registration form and present their certificate of completion for the online class to the instructor if this signature hasn't already been obtained. Field study students will be issued a Hunter Safety book for review and to answer Chapter Review Questions in the back of the book before reporting to the range. Home Study students need to bring their book to class. A \$1.00 class fee will be collected from everyone at the range. Guns and ammunition are provided for the class however students must bring a #2 pencil, a face mask (must wear), and eye protection (to be used while shooting clays.)

Class will include a review of materials in the Hunter Safety book, gun safety review and "show me" session prior to a final exam. To pass the class you must complete your study portion (online class or home study class), attend class for the entire 4-hour session, and pass the hunter safety exam proctored by the instructor.

Please understand that there is limited space in this class and offered on a first come, first served basis. Priority will be given to those 10 years and older. No refunds will be issued.

Parents who attend with their child will be counted in the total of seats available (18) so make sure to register the adult if they plan to stay. If your student is under the age of 11, a parent or guardian **must** attend with the participant.
