(limit 3 guests/hunter)**

Harvest a deer and hang it on the Bath Township Parks & Recreation Buck Pole to be entered into the contest to win a prize. Each successful hunter hanging a deer may bring up to 3 guests for the event. Unfortunately, to attend the Buck Pole, you must be 1 of 3 invited by the successful hunter due to the Governor's social distancing guidelines. Everyone in attendance must social distance at 6' and wear a mask. Those not invited and wishing to view the Pole can drive by on Drumheller Road.

- Representatives from **Commemorative Bucks of Michigan**, Dick Wilt & Roger Dunham, will be on hand to score the bucks and determine winners.
- The Adult Buck Pole winner will be awarded a CVA Scout .450 Legend rifle donated in partnership with **Gunz-n-Gripz of Bath**. 2nd place will receive a BoneView Power Hot Pocket [handwarmer with full grip heating at 2 temperature settings of (109-120 and lasting up to 6 hours), bright LED flashlight with safety strobe option, charger (mobile phone, camera, and BoneView Toe Warmers)].
- The Youth Buck Pole winner will receive a European Mount of their trophy donated by Roger Dunham of E. Lansing.
- **Bath Township** will offer refreshments to those in attendance. (Chili will be served this year.)
