Curbside-only service is available for residents age 65+, or who are physically disabled and can't bring their materials to the drop-off site.

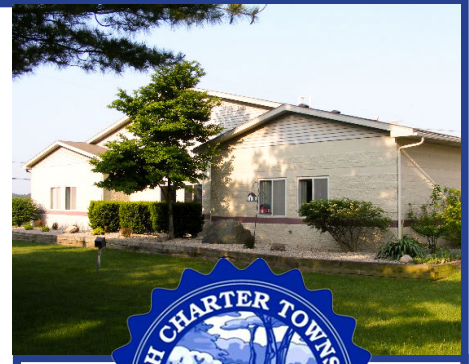
