#### **New Voter Card Information**

All registered voters in Bath Charter Township will soon be mailed a new Voter Information Card indicating any district changes. This is required by law. When voters receive their new Voter Information Card, they should carefully look over the information as a number of residents will have had a change in their State, Federal, or local representation. While this card is not required for voting, as picture ID is acceptable, the card does contain important voting location and district information.


Some residences may receive Voter Information Cards for voters that no longer live at those residences. The most common reason this happens is because voters either moved, and did not change their address on their Michigan driver's license, or they have moved out of state and did not inform the Secretary of State's Office, or their local clerk. If this happens, please mark "unknown" and place the ID card back for proper handling by the USPS.

#### **Cemetery Rules & Regulations**

It is important that all cemetery rules and regulations be followed in order for the Township to properly maintain our cemeteries and to avoid damage to flowers, decorations, and other items. **Tags will be placed on graves not in compliance with any rules or regulations and will be allowed 30 days to correct the violation.** After this time, the Township reserves the right to remove, and dispose of, without notice to the owner any unsightly, deteriorated, neglected, or prohibited items except monuments or markers.

- Artificial flowers, shrubs, or similar ornamentation shall not be placed on the ground between April 15 and October 15. Artificial flowers may be placed in an urn if they are properly secured.
- Flowers may be planted only within 12 inches of the front of the monument or marker and under no circumstances will such planting be allowed outside the boundaries of the owner's burial space(s).
- The use of stone, limestone, woodchips, mulch, etc. is prohibited.
- Chairs, settees, and benches on lots are prohibited.
