2021 Medication Collection

Help protect Michigan's water supply and avoid medication falling into the wrong hands - do not flush or pour your expired or unused medications down the drain! Bring your expired, unused pill, tablet, or capsule drugs to the Bath Township Police Department for proper disposal. Please no inhalers, patches, injectables (sharp objects), empty containers, or leaking liquids. Pills, tablets, or capsules must be brought in their original bottle (please black out personal information) and place the bottle into the secure location during office hours.
