
### Sewer Rate Increase

The Sanitary Sewer Rate will increase to \$114.14 per REU (residential equivalent unit) per quarter, effective January 1, 2023. This new rate is reflected on the December 2022 sewer bills.

The Bath Charter Township Board of Trustees reviews Sanitary Sewer Rates each year as part of its annual budget process to ensure there is enough funding for treatment costs and maintenance projects. Regular expenses include repairing and maintaining our collection system, which consists of lift stations, pipes, and manholes. In the coming year, Bath Township will be contributing significantly to the cost of upgrading the operations at the Southern Clinton County Utilities Authority (SCCMUA) in DeWitt, as well as maintenance to the Township's infrastructure here in Bath.
