Registration begins April 1, 2024: Registration information will be available at the end of March on the <u>Township website</u> and mailed to all property owners.


Dispose of household items - including furniture, electronics, and appliances - at the Township during the annual Tom King Memorial Junk Day event.

Cemetery Reminders

- Artificial flowers, shrubs, or similar ornamentation shall not be placed on the ground between April 15 and October 15, both inclusive. Artificial flowers may be placed in an urn if they are properly secured.
- Grave blankets and other types of winter decorations shall be removed by April 15.
- The planting of trees and shrubbery shall be done only after approval by cemetery staff as to species, variety, location, and time of planting.
- Flowers may be planted only within 12" of the front of the monument or marker and under no circumstances will such planting be allowed outside the boundaries of the owner's burial space(s).
