
Webster Road Closure June 10 - July 4

Webster Road between Somerset Lane and Drumheller Road will be closed beginning June 10 until July 4 for a Clinton County Road Commission (CCRC) permit project to raise the roadway grade to improve safe sight distances, in advance of upcoming paving, sidewalk, and site development projects. All residents will be required to follow the posted detour. A map is available below and on the homepage of the Township website. Detour routes will also be posted for northbound and southbound Webster Road traffic. Limited access for emergency services will be maintained through the site to the greatest extent possible. The I-69 ramps will remain open, with access maintained north to Somerset Lane and Food Court Drive, and south to Park Lake Road. Changes Are Coming to the Permanent Absentee Application List!

The permanent absentee application list is being phased out with the 2024 elections. In its place will be the permanent mail ballot list. If you select the permanent mail ballot box in the top right-hand corner of your application, you will automatically be mailed a ballot for any election you are eligible to vote in. Selecting this box means you will no longer need to fill out the absentee application to receive an absentee ballot. If you choose not to select the permanent mail box, you can still request an absentee ballot, but will need to request that ballot either online, by mail, or at the Clerk's Office by filling out an absentee application for the upcoming election.

Selecting the permanent mail ballot will give you some other options to vote. You may return the ballot by mail, drop box, or to the Clerk's Office as an absentee ballot. You may also vote this ballot in person during the early voting period or on Election Day. Simply bring your ballot with you to the polls and cast that ballot.

It will be the voter's responsibility to notify the Clerk if you are going to be temporarily away from your permanent address. In these instances, the Clerk will need your temporary address to send your ballot to you. Ballots cannot be forwarded by mail. If you will need your absentee ballot mailed to an address other than your permanent address, please call the Clerk's Office at (517) 641-6728.
